Certificate of Roadworthiness Scheme

The certificate of Roadworthiness Scheme operates to minimise the use of UNSAFE vehicles on the road. A Certificate of Roadworthiness is required to be presented to VicRoads prior to the transfer of registration of a vehicle or (re) registration of an unregistered vehicle. A Certificate of Roadworthiness may also be requested to clear a Defect Notice Issued by a Police Officer or an Authorised VicRoads Officer.

Certificate of Roadworthiness

An examining mechanic performs an examination and test of the vehicle within guidelines and directions given by VicRoads. If no cause for rejection is found a Certificate of Roadworthiness is issued by the Licensed Vehicle Tester. The Certificate is current and can be used for a transaction for a period of 30 Days from the date of issue. A Certificate of Roadworthiness inspection is a check at the vehicle, to ensure that components have not worn or deteriorated to the extent that the vehicle may not be safe for normal road use. Consumers are strongly advised to obtain an INDEPENDENT comprehensive inspection report on the vehicle's overall condition before purchasing any used vehicle.
